

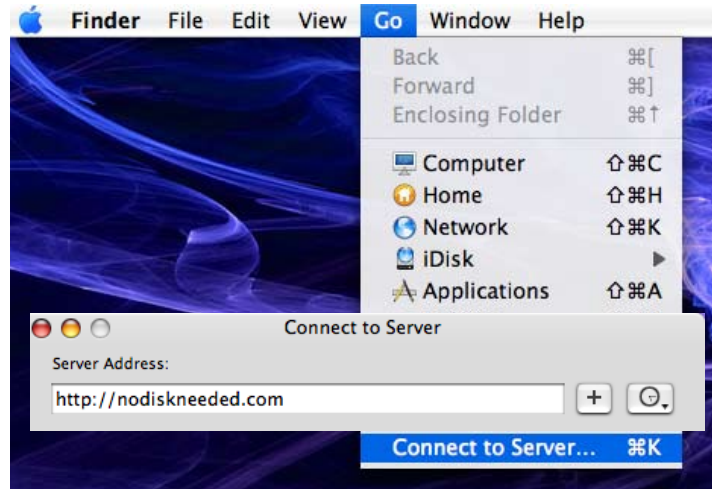
You can connect to our FTP server in a number of ways. To use a web browser, enter www.nodiskneeded.com in the address bar to access the login page.

If you wish to use an FTP client such as Cyberduck (Mac) or Filezilla (Windows) enter nodiskneeded.com as the server address and enter your username and password.

To connect directly from your Desktop, use the following instructions:

Mac OS X: From the Finder click the Go Menu and choose “Connect to Server.”

Enter <http://nodiskneeded.com> as the address (Notice it is “http” *not* “ftp”) After a few moments you will be prompted to enter your username and password. After you enter your login information, you will see the server mounted on your desktop. You may now drag and drop files and folders onto this disk as you would any other disk.



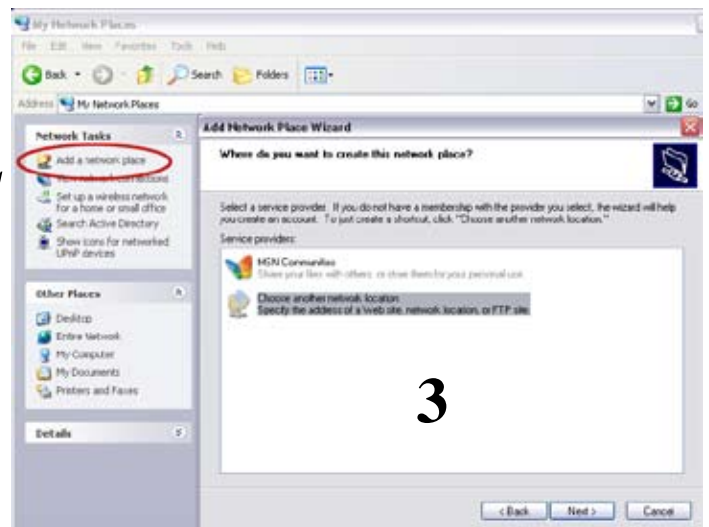
Windows XP: Windows requires a few more steps to achieve this:

- 1: Click on the Start Menu and Choose Network Places
- 2: Click the link for “Add a network place”
- 3: Click “Choose another network location” then click Next
- 4: Enter <ftp://nodiskneeded.com> as the address then click Next
- 5: Uncheck Log on anonymously and enter your username then click Next
- 6: Enter a name or click Next to accept the default name
- 7: Click Finish

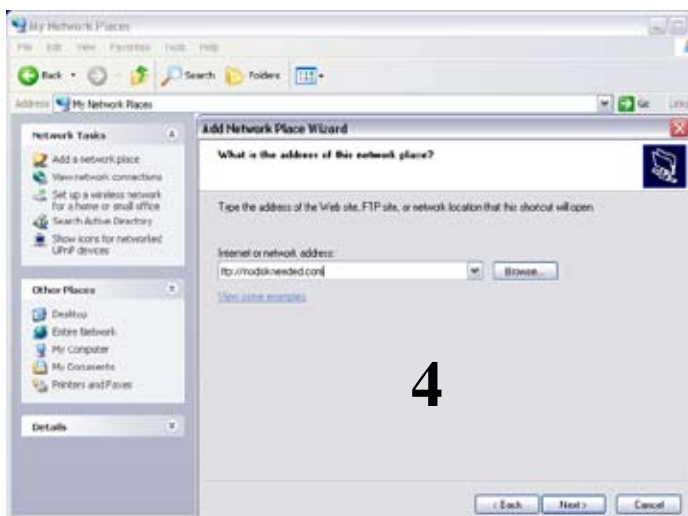
Now you can access the server from Network Places.



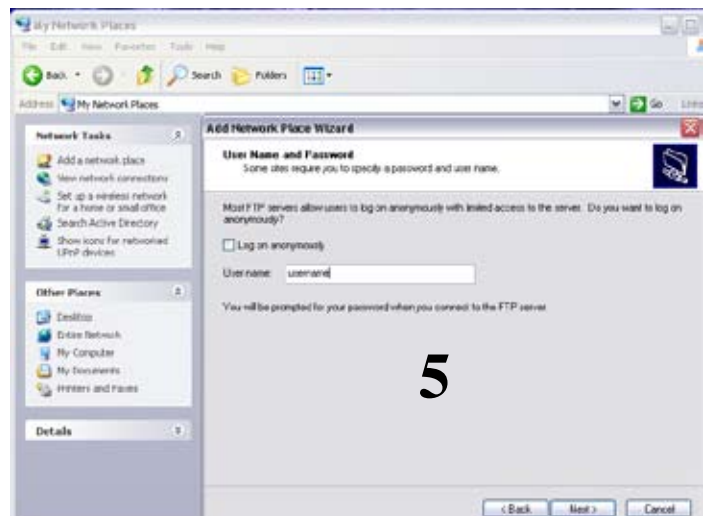
